

No access to v-Tuner / Internetradio

v-Tuner is an independent streaming service that is built as a hub for the use of Internet radio. v-Tuner is providing Podcast and Internet radio stations for manufacturers of home audio electronic to make their customers use of Internet radio, by using the electronic device as a hub, like for other streaming services.

The Company "Nothing Else Matters Software, Ltd." is running this Platform as owner of the streaming service. As a matter of fact, they have decided to change their business concept from "free of charge service" to "payed subscription service".

We as manufacturer cannot affect this decision, since we are not the owner of this Streaming Service. The Company "Nothing Else Matters Software Ltd." is free to change their business concept at any time, like all other Streaming Services can do. We as manufacturer just offer the gateway to use v-Tuner as Streaming Service.

In general v-Tuner is still accessible and you can continue to use v-Tuner if you follow their subscription of a yearly contract with a fee of 3,00US\$ / year. This yearly fee is charged by the Company *Nothing Else Matters Software, Ltd.* After signing in, you can access v-tuner again.

All Yamaha Audio devices, that are equipped with the MusicCast Multi Room function received an update to change the Internet radio Streaming Service from v-Tuner to AirAble, which is a new, so far, free of charge Internet radio Streaming Service. Older Yamaha Audio devices, without MusicCast, cannot be updated, due to technical reasons.

In that case, the only alternative is to use options like Bluetooth or Airplay to stream Internet radio content via your smart device.
