A total of 44 scholarships in 33 countries will be awarded to full-time students in 2026/27.

Application Process

The rules of participation vary between individual countries. For UK and Ireland they are as follows:

- Three scholarships of 2,000 euros each are being offered for UK and Ireland.
- Applicants should be born after 1st April 2001 and must be a current student enrolled on a full-time music course at a UK or Ireland conservatoire or university.
- Applicants should complete the online application form and upload it together with a video recording of two titles (from October 2026).
- The two titles may be recorded separately, but the individual titles may not be cut, re-edited, overdubbed, etc.
- The quality of the sound and video does not influence the later selection process
- The music pieces should represent two different styles and the total length of both pieces together should not exceed 20 minutes.

The closing date for applications is midnight on 30th November 2026.

- After the November deadline there will be a pre-selection based on the submitted recordings
- 10 finalists will be invited to perform, location (within UK/Irl) and date will be announced later
- A jury of well-known professors and people from the world of music will award three scholarship holders
