Putting the Speaker in Speakerphone

Connecting Your UC 500

- Remove UC 500, AC adapter, and USB cable from box.
- 2. Connect the appropriate plug clip to the AC adapter.
- Connect one end of the USB cable to your computer, and the other end to the connector on the bottom of the UC 500.

- Connect the AC adapter to the power connector labelled DC 15V on the bottom of the UC 500 and the other end to a power source.
- When booting up, the LEDs on the UC 500 will change between red, green, and amber lights. When the UC 500 is ready to use, the LEDs will display solid green lights and the device will emit a chime.

Key Operations

the UC 500 is dependent on the computer volume and device volume up and down cap touch buttons. Volume is increased using the cap-touch button on the top left of the device. Touch this icon on the base unit or touch and hold to increase the volume. A tone will play to indicate the volume level as it increases. A double tone will play once maximum volume is reached. Volume is decreased



using the button on the top right of the device. Touch this icon on the base unit or touch and hold to decrease the volume. A tone will play to indicate the volume level as it is being decreased. A double tone will play once minimum volume is reached.

- Mute/Unmute: The microphones will be muted when this button is touched. Press the button again to unmute. Red LEDs indicate muted microphones. Green LEDs indicate unmuted microphones.
- 3. Accept Call: To accept a call from the unit, touch this button.*
- 4. Hang Up Call: To hang up a call from the unit, touch this button.*

*Accept Call & Hang Up Call button functionality only available for use with compatible software configured with the Revolabs FLX UC Device Manager: Refer to Item 6 in the Connecting your UC 500 section for instructions on how to download the software application.
