



DTX-MULTI 12 Extension Installation Guide

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About DTX-MULTI 12 Extension

DTX-MULTI 12 Extension is software which lets you operate the Cubase functions from the DTX-MULTI 12 as a remote controller. For example, you can operate the Cubase transport, turn its metronome on or off, and control various other functions from the instrument's front panel.

Minimum System Requirements

Windows/Macintosh

The system requirements of DTX-MULTI 12 Extension are the same as Cubase / Cubase Studio / Cubase Essential / Cubase AI version 5.1.0 or later.

NOTE Keep in mind that the software is often updated and the system requirements are subject to change. You can check the latest version information of each program and its system requirements at the following website:

The system requirements may differ slightly depending on the particular computer.

NOTE DTX-MULTI 12 Extension is not compatible with versions of Cubase earlier than 4.x.

Software Installation

To use the DTX-MULTI 12 Extension, you will need to install additional applications, as described below.

1 Install a DAW software, such as Cubase.

2 Install an appropriate USB-MIDI Driver.

3 Install the DTX-MULTI 12 Extension.

Installing the DTX-MULTI 12 Extension

Follow the instructions below to install the DTX-MULTI 12 Extension programs.

Windows

1 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the "setup.exe" file.

The DTX-MULTI 12 Extension setup dialog appears.

NOTE When using Windows Vista, if the "User Account Control" window appears, click [Continue].

2 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.

Macintosh

1 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the "Yamaha DTX-MULTI 12 Extension.pkg" file.

The DTX-MULTI 12 Extension setup dialog appears.

2 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.

DTX-MULTI 12 Extension Uninstall

When using Windows XP

- 1 From the Start menu, select ([Settings] →) [Control Panel] → [Add or Remove Programs] to display the “Add or Remove Programs” panel.
- 2 Click “Change or Remove Programs” located in the upper left, then select “Yamaha DTX-MULTI 12 Extension” from the list in the right pane.
- 3 Click [Change/Remove].
A dialog box appears. Follow the instructions to remove the software.

When using Windows Vista

- 1 From the Start menu, select ([Settings] →) [Control Panel] → [Programs and Features] to display the “Uninstall or change a program” window.
- 2 Select “Yamaha DTX-MULTI 12 Extension” from the list.
- 3 Click [Uninstall/Change].
If the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue].
A dialog box appears. Follow the instructions to remove the software.

When using a Macintosh computer

- 1 Select [Library] → [Application Support] → [Steinberg] → [Components], then delete the below files.
 - yamaha_dtx-multi_12_u.bundle

Button Functions in Cubase Remote Mode

Button	Operation
[SHIFT] + [MIDI]	Turns the Cubase Remote function on and off.
[KIT]	Opens the VSTi window.
[PTN]	Starts and stops playback.
[SHIFT] + [PTN]	Starts recording.
[-/DEC], [+ /INC]	Increases or decreases a preset by 1.
[<]	Rewinds the transport (REW).
[>]	Fast forwards the transport (FF).
[VA]	Returns the transport to the start of the song (TOP).
	Turns the click track on and off.

NOTE Cubase functions assigned to the buttons can be changed as desired from the Device Setup menu in Cubase.
